

## Hardware revision

This revision shall in no case include powering the main system of the platform. Any test requiring power supply to the main system shall be performed during the “*Functional system test*”.

If any component needs to be powered for testing, it must be powered independently without recourse to the main power supply system.

The hardware revision will depend on the platform and its respective maintenance manual, but the following points may be common.

However, each customer should have its own checklist, as it is only an example provided by Embention as an aid.
