Quick Start

Veronte Cloud provides the remote interface and data administration platform for autopilots and users.

Access to Veronte Cloud is subject to specific permissions. Having an account does not grant access to the platform, as it must be enabled according to the operator's authorizations.

System Requirements

Before executing this software, users should check the following sections with the minimum and recommended PC hardware requirements.

Minimum requirements

- CPU: Intel Core i5-8365UE
- RAM: 8 GB DDR4
- STO: 256 GB SSD

Recommended requirements


- CPU: 12th Gen Intel(R) Core(TM) i7-12700H 14 cores up to 4,70 GHz

System Access

Veronte Cloud is a platform, therefore **no** local software installation is required. To get started, users only need to navigate to the [Veronte Cloud](#) web page.


Operation






To assign an application to the user account, check the designated box.






- Edit: Name and Role of the user can be modified. In addition, the **User manager** option can be enabled or disabled.

- Finally, click **Reset**.

Components panel

- Search:** The purpose of the marked fields is to search for a component by **Name**, **Type** or **SIM Number**.

Once the component search data has been entered, click **Apply** to start the search or **Reset** to remove the input data.



Components panel - Apply/Reset button


2. **Index:** Component index in the list of components.
3. **Name:** Name assigned to the component.
4. **Type:** A label used to categorize the component. It can be Autopilot, Vehicle, Engine or Battery.
5. **Weight:** Component weight. Can be added by the user.
6. **Active:** Report the component status.
 - If this icon is represents that the component is **active**.
 - If this icon appears as represents that the component is **NOT active**.
7. **SIM Number:** The SIM number will only appear if the component has a valid 4G activation license.

8. Options:

- Assign users: It enables the assignment of a component to one or more users.




Troubleshooting

Access Failed

If you enter your credentials and the access fails, it may be because your account does not have permission to access this platform.


First, you must confirm with your organization that you are authorized to access the platform, as normally only one user from each organization will have authorization.

Next, another user who already has access should check whether your account has the **User manager** option enabled in the [Users panel](#):

- If the option appears as  , the

user account does not have permission to access the **Veronte Cloud** platform.

To grant access, simply enable it from the [Options settings](#) of the user account.

- Otherwise, if it appear as  , the account

has already permission to access the **Veronte Cloud** platform.
